

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Visual Methodology Mastery Kit for Soft Skills Instruction

- We are proud to announce that the Visual Methodology Mastery Kit for Soft Skills Instruction is now complete.
- This toolkit is designed to help adult educators integrate visual thinking into their soft skills training, providing ready-to-use materials, visuals, and activities that make learning engaging and inclusive.
- The kit features a series of visually explained soft skills modules, each focused on developing key competencies essential for personal and professional growth.
- Modules included in the toolkit:
 - Communication Skills
 - Social Manners
 - Social Norms and Inappropriate Behaviour
 - Teamwork and Collaboration
 - Decision-Making
 - Problem-Solving
 - Adaptability and Resilience
 - Time Management
 - Leadership
 - Emotional Intelligence
- Each module contains a combination of visual guides, examples, and practical exercises to support understanding and application. Educators can use these resources to enhance classroom interaction and ensure that vulnerable adult learners can relate to, practice, and strengthen their soft skills effectively.



The SkillVista Online Platform

The SkillVista online platform is now available and fully functional.

It provides educators and learners with access to all project resources and interactive challenges that encourage skill development through experiential learning.

The platform includes the following features:

- Sort It Out! – Challenge
- We Should / We Should Not
- Challenges – Quiz
- Scenarios
- SkillBuilder Challenges – Modules

These elements are designed to engage learners through a variety of approaches, combining visual, reflective, and problem-solving tasks that encourage active participation and deeper understanding of soft skills.

Highlights from the Training in Amsterdam

In July, project partners gathered in Amsterdam for a two-day training event.

The focus of this meeting was to explore the Visual Methodology Mastery Kit and the SkillVista platform, review their structure and usability, and ensure the tools are aligned with the needs of adult educators working with vulnerable adults.

During the training, partners participated in demonstrations, discussions, and evaluation sessions.

This collaborative event allowed the partnership to refine the final outputs and prepare for the next phase of the project.

At present, pilot testing and deep dissemination activities are ongoing in all partner countries.
